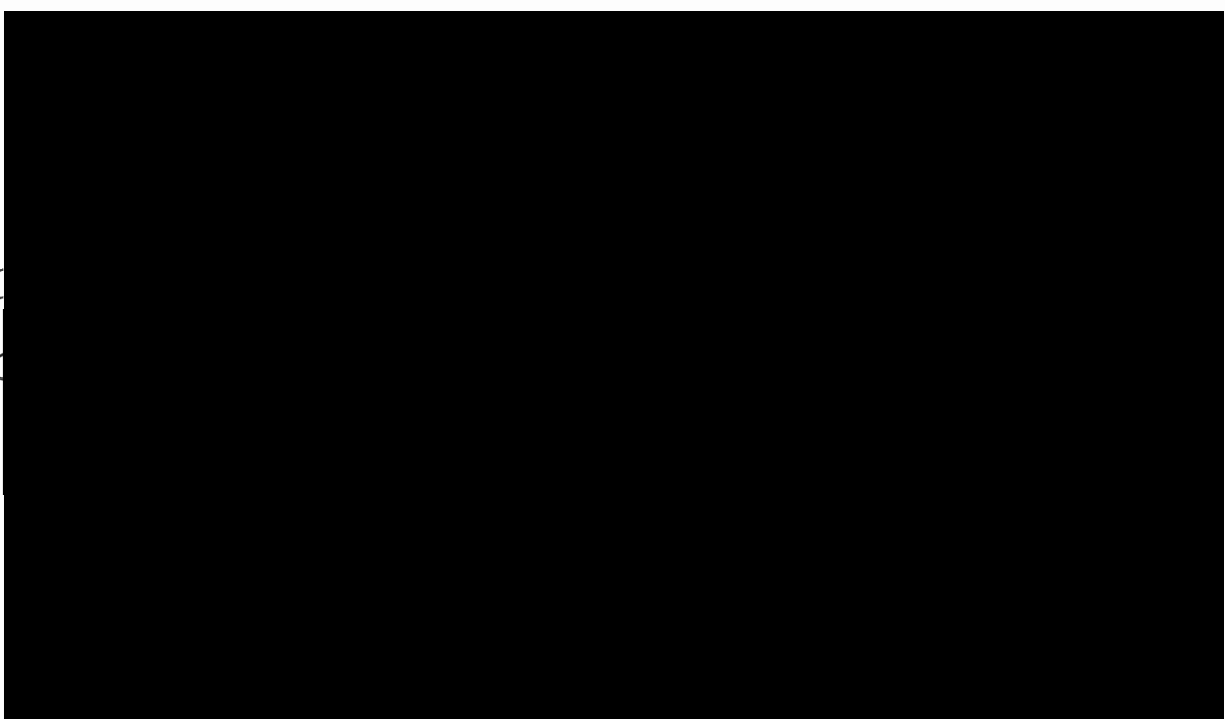

We feel that conducting interviews in this manner diffuses the issues and is an ineffective way of dealing with a community problem.
