To: The Committee on Financial Aid and Admission Policy

From: The General Committee

We ask that the Committee on Financial Aid and Admission Policy:

1. Develop policy and procedures and specific numbers for admission of poverty-style, high-risk students black or white.
2. Consider developing and recommending special programs for such students, such as 2/3 credit programs (which would mean 2/3 tuition cost); possibility of work-study full-year tutor assigned on 1-to-1 basis to each of these students.
3. Determine the specific amount of money to be set aside for such a program.
