Dear Concerned Students of Color,

We have read your proposal carefully. It is clear at this point that our two proposals are still far apart, but we are committed as you are to making changes that are permanent. We want to listen to you and talk with you. A group of faculty and administrators has been appointed to begin work with you to find points of agreement.

We are concerned about your continued occupation of Westlands which is causing serious problems for the functioning of the College.

In the interest of achieving permanent structural change at Sarah Lawrence, we will discuss every issue you have raised, including what we understand to be your priorities; tenure-track appointments, a Center for People of Color, and an administrator for multi-cultural affairs.
