To: The Faculty/Administration Negotiating Team and the SLC Community
From: Concerned Students of Color

On Tuesday May 2, 1989 the Concerned Students of Color met with the Executive Board of the Trustees and the Faculty/Administration Negotiating Committee. In this meeting we addressed our reasons for breaking off negotiations, clarified the development of our agenda and discussed the disparities between the objectives of the two committees.

We feel that dialouge with the Trustees was meaningful in that issues were discussed in a concise and serious way. This meeting brought the various decision making bodies together and clairfied the respective responsibilities and decison making power of students, faculty, administration, and the Board of Trustees.

We hope that this meeting has set the tone for more immediate and effective action around diversifying SLC. Recognizing that this process will be a long one we maintain that these issues must be a priority for the college and the emphasis be placed on structural change.
