To: The Black Students Association

Dear Sisters,

Because of our struggle here, we realize moreso than ever the need for all Black people to work together for the betterment of society. Although you could not support us physically in our occupation of the Institute, we don't know how to thank you for the invaluable work you have done on the campus. We hope that our struggle is your struggle for black people. We want you to know that everything we have done is because we love black people and because we love all the Sisters in the Black Students Association. We realize that many times we've been irrational and dogmatic, but this is only because we know the struggle is so urgent if black people are to survive. We realize we were wrong in leaving the Black Students Association, we apologize for all that it's worth, and would like to ask permission to rejoin the Black Students Association.
